Drawing on the life and legacy of Matilda Joslyn Gage, the **Girl Ambassadors for Human Rights Program** empowers and inspires young women to become agents of change on the local, national, and global stage. Meetings, speakers, and activities delve into a wide range of topics including reproductive rights, human trafficking, women in media, the suffrage movement, feminism, and the complex relationship within various countries between religion, the economy, and the status of women. By the end of the program the girls gain a rich and deeply personal understanding of the evolution of women in society and the obstacles women still face today. Each Girl Ambassador has the opportunity to:

- Meet other young women from across the county
- Gain public speaking skills
- Learn directly from experts and community leaders
- Engage in safe, supportive dialogue
- Personally interview a woman leader of her choice
- Volunteer in support of an issue that matters to her

Applications will be available on August 17th, but now is the perfect time to recommend this program to your students, daughters, and volunteers. Recommendations are required for all applicants. We can accept up to three students per high school, and a total of 20 students. Twelve high schools were represented last year.
